## Curriculum

You will find an outline of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ grade math curriculum on my website.
We use the $3^{\text {rd }}$ grade CA standard based Singapore math books. We will be using the $3 A$ and 3B textbooks and workbooks. The 3A books will be handed out at the beginning of the year; the 3B books will be handed out around mid-year.

## Independent Practice/Homework

Homework in math is assigned Monday through Thursday, and students are expected to show their work, unless otherwise instructed. Homework often consists of workbook or practice pages along with corrections from the prior night's assignment. Corrections are noted by a tab in the workbook. Corrections are a required part of nightly homework. Homework assignments are due at the start of the next school day (by 8:30 a.m.).

Extra Practice is available on my website. To get credit for the Extra Practice, any worksheets done must be turned in by Friday of each week with a parent signature on the front page.

## Tests \& Drills

Tests and computation drills are given once a week on Fridays. (There are some exceptions to this, so please check the weekly homework sheet.) If you would like to practice your math facts before a drill, practice drills can be found on my website and may be turned in for Extra Practice. The goal of these drills is to keep up computation skills so that students have the basic math facts memorized to automaticity.

Graded tests and computation drills will be recorded on Gradelink.
